The purpose of this program is to assist eligible households to obtain stable housing through financial assistance and case management.

- There's 3 parts to being eligible for ERAP:
  - 1. Be within the income limits.
  - Not currently receiving the same services from another program:
    a. Can't be receiving rental assistance from another program and receive rental assistance from this program at the same time.
    - b. You can be receiving rental assistance from another program and receive case management assistance from this program.
  - 3. Experiencing homelessness (on the streets or in a shelter) or living in unstable housing conditions/at risk of homelessness.

In some cases. This program can pay for a security deposit and one month of rent for people who are experiencing homelessness. The program does not cover rental arrears, application fees, or utility deposits.

After we receive the referral, a navigator will contact the application to determine eligibility and complete an intake.
